**JOB PURPOSE:** Lifeguards will work all over the facility guarding pools and slides. They may also be required to provide basic first aid and respond to emergency situations.

- Provide basic first aid and respond to aquatic emergency situations as required
- Monitor supply inventories and alert their manager of any potential replenishment needs
- Provide exceptional guest service to park visitors
- Maintain a clean and safe work environment.
- Complete reports and daily operations form as required
- Attend scheduled in-service training sessions
- Responsible for making sure all team members comply with the company values and are completing our mission
- Comply with all required COVID-19 health and safety protocols as per company policy, and determined by public health guidelines

### **WORK ENVIRONMENT:**

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is exposed to weather conditions prevalent at the time. This position requires occasional work in or around wetness, confined spaces-cramped quarters, heights, noise, detergents/chemicals, mechanical hazards, moving objects, fumes/odors, dust, mists, gases, or vibrations. The noise level is generally moderate.
