### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Staff the First Aid Centre or respond to First Aid calls in the park
- Provide First Responder level care to guests or staff as required
- Activate the Emergency Action Plan when required
- Ensure that opening and closing procedures are completed.
- Ensure that all documentation is completed correctly, legibly and in a timely manner.
- Ensure that the appropriate incident information has been reported to Supervisor.
- Interact with management regarding safety, general liability, workers' compensation, and other issues.
- Periodically meet with Supervisor throughout the operating day to discuss any relevant issue or incidents.
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time.
- Must be able to work in all types of weather conditions.
- Must be available to work varied shifts Monday through Sunday.

### **SKILLS AND ABILITIES**

- Guest focused
- Team player
- Ability to communicate well, verbally and in written form
- Hears and listens well
- Ability to interpret written, oral, and diagnostic form instructions.
- Ability to use good judgment and remain calm in high stress situations.
- Ability to calculate weight and volume rations and read small print both under life threatening time restrictions.
- Ability to read and understand English language manuals, texts, and maps.

- Ability to converse and comprehend English effectively.
- Ability to appropriately interview patient, family members, bystanders, and witnesses.
- Ability to document in writing, all relevant information in a prescribed format.
- Good manual dexterity, with ability to perform all tasks related to the highest quality of patient care.
- Ability to walk, run, bend, stoop, and crawl on uneven terrain.
- Ability to withstand varied environmental conditions such as extreme heat, cold, moisture, dryness, etc.
- Ability to work in low light, confined spaces, and potentially hazardous materials.

- Possesses and maintains at minimum a valid CPR Level C Certificate
