

JOB TITLE: Pool Tech

Department: Maintenance

Job Purpose:

Pool Tech will work under the direction of the Maintenance Manager and assist in the cleaning and maintenance of all park pools and facilities as needed. Previous pool technician experience, and skills with hand tools is an asset.

Job Duties:

Check pools for dirt and debris daily and use specialized equipment to extract both.

Perform cleaning and maintenance work on pools.

Backwash pool water filter to keep the pool clean.

Check the chemistry of the pools and adjust chemical feeds as necessary.

Scrub pool floors and walls using sponges, soap, and chemicals.

Perform vacuuming activities in hard-to-reach places inside the pool.

Clean and maintain pumprooms to ensure work area free of debris.

Empty pool traps and filters and replace either or both in case of wear and tear or malfunction.

Fill the pool with water after maintenance activities have been performed and check for appropriate pool chemistry.

Mix chemicals in appropriate quantities to ensure appropriate chemical levels are maintained

Maintain pool water levels by checking gauges.

Perform maintenance work on areas around the pools as needed.

Perform minor fixture adjustments and repairs around the pool.

Supervise extensive repair work being performed in the pool or around it.

Store pool equipment and tools in a proper manner.

Check pool filtration motors and equipment regularly.

Job description

Maintenance technicians at Wet 'n' Wild Toronto are responsible for the general upkeep and safety of our, buildings, utilities, infrastructure, and attractions on a daily basis. Some of the physical duties assigned to Maintenance Technicians are:

- Daily Preventative maintenance inspections of all attractions and key equipment.
- Monitoring, inspecting, performing predictive and reactive maintenance to filtration and water treatment equipment, pumping lift stations and building systems.
- Assisting with the implementation of new equipment and updating existing systems to meet the parks efficiency and lean goals.
- Repair and maintenance of the parks various, pneumatic, control, HVAC, electrical and plumbing systems. This position requires associates to document much of their work for compliance with various regulatory requirements as well as work in an "on call" capacity while on shift.

1.Applicants must be fluent in English and have excellent reading and writing skills.

2.Applicants must be able to communicate effectively through use of various systems such as, online notebooks, documentation databases, and two-way radio.
